Minutes of the previous meeting

Matt read them out and they were accepted as a true record.

Matters Arising

- GW-Winter Mats, Gordon has spoken to AA Wright re: estimate. The head green keeper will provide a costing; Gordon thinks the men's section will be able to provide some new mats for the winter.
- 150-yard markers, again this has been questioned if these are to the front or middle as some are to the front and some to the middle. Matt will have them checked again.

Junior Report

Matt was able to provide some information in the absence of Roy Hickman. The fixtures have now been completed. The Junior championships to be held next Monday, it was confirmed the bar would be open.

Course

- The cutting at the bottom of the banks has been done
- There has been a new green staff member joined for the summer to do strimming etc..
- There are 4 green keepers at present and this will be the total amount employed
- Two weeks ago the green keeper shed had been broken into and the keys to the machinery had been stolen along with the head green keepers car. This had disrupted the cutting
- There have been a number of incidents on the course, the most recent a fire on the 6th green. The police have been informed and community officers are doing spot checks.
- The greens have seen a vast improvement, which links back to the work previously done. They are currently running at 8 on the stint meter, however the aim is to get them to 10.
- GW commented on how good the course is at the minute and all reiterated this.

Competitions

- GW-The men's championship has 48 players starting from 07.30
- Men's Captains day, all sections will be playing, the aim is to let it run through finishing approx 4.30pm
- The Ladies invitation day has 16 pairs which is quite a good response
- The Ladies Open- unfortunately there is only one group of non craythorne members, it has been decided by the ladies section that it would not be viable to run, Matt to speak to AA Wright regarding this.
- The Pro shop-had stopped two ladies playing in a competition because now one else had entered. The ladies handicap secretary along with Matt will speak to them.
- Matt explained about the new competition in September, the Craythorne cross-country. It is at present in draft format. There will be food included in the price. It is planned as a shotgun start for 5.30pm.

Membership

- There will be a new membership category, Mr AA Wright to hold a meeting to announce to present members and guests on the 17th September. The principle is that there will be a joining fee of approx £200 and then each time they play they will pay a discounted green fee. They will have full membership rights to enter competitions and hold a handicap.

Social Committee
